ORDER

The applications submitted by various educational agencies, vide paper read (1) above, for starting New Programmes/Additional Batches/Permanent Seat Increase in existing Unaided Self Financing Arts & Science Colleges during the academic year 2022-'23 were considered by University and Inspection Commissions were constituted vide papers (2), (3), (4), (5) and (6) read above, to assess the instructional and infrastructural facilities provided by the respective educational agencies to start the proposed programmes.

The Syndicate Sub Committee on Affiliation and Approval held on 31.05.2022 vide paper read (7) above, examined the Inspection Commission Reports in detail and recommended to grant provisional affiliation in accordance with the Government NOC.Hon'ble Vice Chancellor approved the recommendations exercising powers under section 3.10(17) of Mahatma Gandhi University Act 1985 and orders were issued accordingly, vide paper read (8) above. The recommendations of the University to start the proposed Programmes were forwarded for the views of the Government of Kerala, vide paper (9) read above.

The Government of Kerala, vide paper (10) above, accorded administrative sanction for starting new Programmes/Batches/Permanent Seat Increase during the Academic Year 2022-'23.

In the light of the above Government order, the University directed the Self-financing college managements vide paper read (11) above, to furnish a copy of signed agreement with the Government along with an affidavit of submission of above to the Department of Higher Education and submit a signed agreement with prescribed clauses, to the University.

Sanction has therefore been accorded by the Pro-Vice Chancellor, in charge of Vice Chancellor to the following colleges, who satisfied the conditions laid by University for starting New Programmes/Additional Batches/ Permanent Seat Increase during the academic year 2022-'23 and to duly include these courses in the CAP 2022-'23.

The affiliation granted shall be subject to the compliance of Act/Statutes/bye-Laws/rules and regulations of the University and UGC on instructional and infrastructural facilities, faculty, qualifications etc. in the colleges.

Provisional affiliation is granted subject to the following conditions:

1. The provisional affiliation is granted initially for a period of one Academic Year only.
2. The affiliation of programmes is subject to the approval of regulatory authority if any.
3. The Management shall prepare and present the students in accordance with the laws of the University for the examination and as per the approved scheme and

syllabus of the University in the subjects concerned.

4. As per G O read (10) above, the Educational Agency shall set apart 50% of the seats of the course for being filled up by the Government or such Authority determined by Government on the basis of merit and reservation principles followed by the Government and the remaining 50% filled by the Educational Agency on the basis of merit.

4. The details of tuition fee and other fees are as detailed below:

- b) Students insurance premium @ Rs.23/- per student per year.
- c) Students welfare fund @ Rs. 35/- per student per year.
- d) University Union fee @ Rs. 55/- per student per year.
- e) Sports affiliation fee @ Rs. 225/- per student per year to be utilised in the ratio @ 50:50 by the University and the college.
- f) The collection of annual administration fee from the students under any circumstances is not permitted.
- g) Student's affiliation fee @ Rs. 600 & 800 /- for UG & PG courses collected on one time basis from all students shall be remitted to the university within 15 days after closing admission.
5. The rate of Tuition Fee is as per Government/University orders issued from time to time.
6. The Educational Agency shall furnish an undertaking in a stamp paper worth Rs.100/- to the University to carry out faithfully, the provisions of the Act, Statute, Ordinance and Regulations and the directions issued by the University from time to time, so far as they are related to the college, and to appoint and fix the service conditions of the teaching & non teaching staff in the college for conducting the courses as followed by the Government on conducting similar courses. The Principal of the college shall endorse the undertaking.
7. The Educational Agency will agree to collect only such fees as determined by the Government/University from time to time from the students admitted to the course.
8. The college shall submit the list of students admitted and remit the fees due to University within 15 days after closing admission.
9. Non-compliance with any of the above conditions would lead to the withdrawal of the affiliation without any prior notice.
