ORDER

The Principal, De Paul Institute of Science & Technology, Angamaly a Self Financing Unaided Arts & Science College applied for new courses as per paper read (1). The Inspection Commission constituted as per paper read (2) submitted its report on 21.05.2010 recommending BCom Computer Application and BCA courses for the academic year 2010-11 and the recommendation was forwarded to Government as per paper read (4). The Government vide G.O. read (5) has accorded administrative sanction for starting B.Com Computer Application and BCA courses with an annual intake of 40 seats each at De Paul Institute of Science & Technology, Angamaly during the academic year 2010-11.

After considering the administrative sanction the Pro-Vice Chancellor in charge of Vice Chancellor exercising power under section 3.10(17) of Mahatma Gandhi University Act, 1985 has granted provisional affiliation for B.Com Computer Application and BCA courses at De Paul Institute of Science & Technology, Angamaly during 2010-11.

Sanction has therefore been accorded to grant provisional affiliation for B.Com Computer Application and BCA courses during 2010-11 at De Paul Institute of Science & Technology, Angamaly with an annual intake of 40 students each.

The provisional Affiliation granted is subject to the following conditions.

First affiliation.

1. The provisional affiliation is granted initially for a period of one academic year only.
2. The Management shall prepare and present the students in accordance with the laws of the University for the examination and as per the approved scheme and syllabus of the University in the subjects concerned.
3. The admission to the above courses shall be made as per the existing norms of the University. In Unaided Colleges 50% of the seats shall be filled by the management from among candidates of their choice provided they satisfy the eligibility conditions prescribed by the University. 65% of the remaining seats (i.e.50%) shall be filled on general merit and 35% shall be filled by candidates belonging to SC/ST and other backward communities in the order of merit with the following quota for each community.

1. Scheduled Caste	-	8%
2. Scheduled Tribe	-	2%
3. Ezhava, Thiyya & Billava	-	9%
4. Muslims	-	8%
5. Latin Catholics other than Anglo Indians	-	2%
6. Other Backward Christians	-	1%
7. Other Backward Hindus	-	5%

4. The Management shall remit all the fees due to the University as follows.

- (g) Students insurance premium @ Rs.2/- per student per year
- (h) Students Welfare Fund @ Rs.10/- per student per year
- (i) University Union Fee @ Rs.30/- per student per year.
- (j) Sports affiliation fee @ Rs.150/- per student per year to be utilized in the ratio 50:50 by the University and the College.

5. Collection of Annual Administration fee from the students under any circumstances is not permitted.
6. Students affiliation fee @ Rs.200/- collected on one time basis from all students shall be remitted to the University within fifteen days after closing of the admission.

7. The Educational Agency shall furnish an undertaking in a stamp paper worth Rs.50/- to the University to carry out faithfully, the provisions of the Act, Statute, Ordinance and Regulations and the directions issued by the University from time to time in so far as they are related to the college. The Principal of the college shall endorse the undertaking.
8. Non-compliance with any of the above conditions would lead to the withdrawal of the affiliation without any notice.

Orders are issued accordingly.
